Likert a scales are a common measurement method in educational contexts. 23 His approach involved the presentation of a set of selected items that together measured one trait, such as satisfaction with a teaching method. Each item was a declarative statement. For each item, the response set consisted of a set of equally spaced numbers accompanied by approximately equally spaced anchors (Fig. 1A).

Behaviorally anchored rating scales (BARS) are scales used to rate performance. BARS are normally presented vertically with scale points ranging from five to nine. It is an appraisal method that aims to combine the benefits of narratives, critical incidents, and quantified ratings by anchoring a quantified scale with specific narrative examples of good, moderate, and poor performance.
